How does a floor finish work?

The solids in a floor finish are what are left on the floor when you apply finish. Once the floor finish is applied, the liquids evaporate leaving behind the protective coating. When you use a finish with a higher amount of solids, obviously there is more material left on the floor, meaning better gloss and protection for your floor.

While this sounds like an obvious choice, they are many factors to consider. Floor finishes with a solids content of 25% and above are thicker and more difficult to apply and fix. This can result in uneven gloss, mop swirls and cause very thick patches of finish that take a long time to dry. Also, because of the additional solids content, the price for these floor finishes are higher and the same results can be achieved with a floor finish of 25% and lower with just a few extra coats! Save yourself the hassle!
