Follow the Leader!

To properly clean a covering covered with floor finish, linoleum or linoleum, follow these steps:



Dusting: Start by sweeping or vacuuming the floor to remove dust, crumbs and debris.

- Prepare a neutral detergent mixture: In a bucket, mix cold water with the detergent at the dilution listed on the label of the chosen product.
- Remove stubborn stains: For stubborn stains, you can use a specific cleaner for a covering covered with floor finish, linoleum recommended by the manufacturer. Follow product instructions for specific stains.
- Use a damp mop or microfiber mop: Dip the mop in the cleaning mixture and wring it out well so it is slightly damp. Avoid using too much water, as this could damage the floor.



Rinse with clean water: After cleaning, rinse the mop with clean water and wipe the floor again to remove any cleaner residue.



Clean the floor: Damp mop the floor, gently wiping away stains and dirt. Work in sections to ensure the entire floor is clean.

Regular maintenance: To keep your floor covered with floor finish, linoleum in good condition, perform regular maintenance by vacuuming or sweeping regularly to remove dust and debris. Clean stains as soon as they appear to prevent them from becoming embedded.

By following these steps and using gentle and suitable products, you will be able to keep your floor covered with floor finish, linoleum clean and in good condition for a long time.
