
Follow the Leader!

To properly clean a shower, follow these steps for sparkling results:

- **Preparation:** Gather all the cleaning supplies you will need, such as bathroom cleaners, a sponge, scrub brush, household gloves and clean rags.
- **Pre-rinse:** Before you start cleaning, rinse the shower walls with hot water to remove soap and shampoo residue.



Cleaning walls and tiles: Spray or apply bathroom cleaner to walls, tiles and grout. Leave for a few minutes to dissolve soap and mildew deposits. Use a sponge or soft brush to scrub, paying particular attention to stained or dirty areas.



- Cleaning the shower door or curtain:

 If you have a glass shower door or shower curtain, clean them using a glass cleaner.

 Be sure to rinse and dry thoroughly after cleaning.

Drying: Wipe all surfaces with a clean cloth or squeegee to avoid water spots and help prevent future buildup of deposits.



Cleaning the grout: If the joints between the tiles are dirty or moldy, apply a mildew product to the joints and leave to act. Then scrub gently with a brush to remove dirt and mold.

Regular Maintenance: To prevent dirt and residue from building up, clean your shower regularly by following these steps or performing a quick wipe after each use.

By following these steps, you should be able to keep your shower clean and fresh, providing a clean and welcoming relaxation space.
