Follow the Leader!

To properly clean toilet bowls and urinals,
here are the steps to follow:

1



Preparation: Before you begin, put on protective gloves to avoid direct contact with germs and cleaning chemicals.

2



Choosing a cleaning product: Use a cleaning product specifically designed for toilet bowls or urinals. You can opt for disinfectant cleaners, descalers or acid-based products to remove stains and bacteria.

Scrub: Once the cleaning product has worked sufficiently, use the toilet brush or urinal brush to scrub all surfaces and remove stubborn stains.

Product application: Pour the cleaning product directly into the toilet bowl or urinal following the manufacturer's instructions. Be sure to cover all areas, including the edges, under the rim, and internal parts of the bowl or urinal.

Rinsing: After scrubbing and deep cleaning, flush the toilet to rinse the bowl or urinal. Make sure all cleaning foam and dirt residue are removed.

Let it work : Leave the product on for the time recommended on the package. This time varies depending on the type of product you use. Never use acid-based cleaning products or other hazardous chemicals in a poorly ventilated room.

Regular maintenance: To maintain optimal hygiene, clean toilet bowls and urinals regularly by following these steps. Avoid using corrosive products that could damage surfaces.

By following these steps, you will be able to keep toilet bowls and urinals clean, disinfected and free of unpleasant odors. Please ensure that you never mix two products inside the toilet bowl or urinal, as they could react and cause a harmful reaction.
